Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America) and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of ASCA's Agility Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS This trial is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting any signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.

Dogs are not required to have an ASCA Registration, ASCA LEP, or Tracking number to enter this trial. Handlers do not need to be ASCA members.

However, as of January 1, 2003, ASCA requires registration of all non-

ASCA registered dogs in order to record and track these dogs for ASCA titles. If you wish to continue to have your qualifying scores recorded and receive ASCA titling certificates, you must register your dog and become a service member of ASCA at the time of registration. We will have forms available at the trial, a form is attached to this premium or you can go to the ASCA website www.asca.org.

RULES OF AGILITY ENTRY FOR THIS TRIAL

Entries will be accepted on the basis of those received on each day.

Confirmations will be mailed or emailed to all entered with information regarding which classes you have entered and check-in times. Directions to the trial site are available at www.teecreek.com. For day of show entry availability call Cheryl Rogalsky 905 842-5928 email cherylk9@pathcom.com prior to 4 p.m. on Wednesday July 23, 2008.

CLUB RULES FOR THE TRIAL

WSDC reserves the right to refuse any entry based on suitable causes only. Any entry refused will be reported to ASCA. Every entrant must be in good standing with ASCA. All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be issued for bitches that come in season, if notification in writing or by email is received before July 30, 2010.

Cheques not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned cheques.

Agility obstacles that may be used include Slatted A-Frame, Slat-less Teeter and Dogwalk, Tire Jump, Tunnels, Winged and Wingless Jumps

No leads, collars, food, toys, other aids or devices will be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the rings at any time.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs receiving titles after the closing date may be upgraded by providing written notice to the Trial Secretary. Letters and e-mails containing the owner's full name, the dog's call name and ASCA (or other) number, entered class, and from and to level are acceptable. No move-ups will be accepted after 8 a.m. on July 28.

PRIZES / AWARDS

Green Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs achieving a qualifying score. Placement ribbons will be awarded to all dogs placing 1st through 4th in each class and jump height; dogs jumping 24" optionally will be combined with the 20+ class. Ribbons/prizes must be picked up during the weekend. They WILL NOT be mailed.

ASCA MEMBERSHIP AND TRACKING NUMBER APPLICATION FORM

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA (including both club officers, directors, employees, and members), Willoughby Stock Dog Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), Tee Creek Dog Training Inc, (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor /owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
