ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: This is a limited Trial. Entry fee is \$40.00 for each Arena class entered and \$45.00 for each Stock Dog Class entered. Entries will close on Thursday, Oct. 1, 2009 at 8:00 pm **OR** when the limit of 10 Stock Dog runs and 30 Arena runs (all classes day) has been reached. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED - HAND DELIVERIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on the alternate list to be drawn up in the same order as they are received. The person making the entry shall be notified of his/her position on the list. In the event any dog is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the alternate list up to and including the day of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the trial for those on the alternate list who did not participate in the trial.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Are allowed to compete

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age.

CKC Miscellaneous Breeds cannot enter CKC events unless they have a Miscellaneous number.

RULES

1. We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property.
2. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, and must be kept on leash or crated, at all times except when competing.
3. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any trial held under CKC rules.
4. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
5. There is limited shade. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, etc.
6. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form before being allowed to compete.
7. Events will be held rain or shine. Dress for the weather.
8. Lunch will be available for sale.
9. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. **All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.**
10. Start time: Registration 7 am - Handlers' Meeting at 7:45 am – Judging 8:00 am
11. **DO NOT** go into any areas that are marked with “**DO NOT ENTER**” signs or caution tape. This is a farm and there are areas that are off limits for your safety as well as the safety of our farm animals

DIRECTIONS TO TEE CREEK

FROM TORONTO:

Take QEW Fort Erie thru Niagara Falls. After McLeod Rd. the next exit is Lyons Creek Road, take the West exit (go right) onto Lyons Creek Rd. Just as you are speeding up, there is a road on your left, (in other words make a right and then a quick left) onto Willodell Road. You are almost there! Go down Willodell Rd. approximately 2 miles. After you cross over Schisler Rd. (still on Willodell), we are the second place on the right. There is a large cover-all building up on the hill. Take the 2nd driveway or last driveway past the house, going back to the training center.

FROM BUFFALO:

Take the QEW Niagara from the Peace Bridge. Take the Lyons Creek exit off of QEW. At the stop sign, turn left onto Lyons Creek Rd. Just over the overpass there is a road on your left. This is Willodell Rd. Turn LEFT onto Willodell. You are almost there! Go down Willodell Rd. approximately 2 miles. After you cross over Schisler Rd., (still on Willodell) we are the 2nd place on your right. Take the last driveway past the house and follow the driveway back to the training center.
